94 employers attend SIAST Palliser career fair

February 1, 2012 – SIAST Palliser Campus hosted its 32nd annual career fair in Moose Jaw today. Students from business, engineering technology, industrial, technology and community services programs had the opportunity to explore employment options with recruiting companies.

Career Fair 2012 sponsored by PotashCorp was organized by the SIAST Palliser Campus Student Employment Services (SES) office. An SES office at each of SIAST's four campuses provides career information, job search and recruitment services to students and employers.
